COMMITTEE LIST 2026

A summary of each Standing Committee's duties and responsibilities is provided below. of each Standing Committee. For further procedural details, consult the Club Bylaws regarding the Nominating Committee and the Show Chair Guideline documents for the Show Committee.

FUND RAISING: The Committee is responsible for developing appropriate fundraising initiatives to benefit the Club treasury and support its mission. All proposed programs require prior approval from the Board of Directors.

GOODWILL COMMITTEE: The Goodwill Committee is responsible for conveying the Club's support to members and their families during times of need by sending appropriate gestures, such as cards or flowers, on behalf of the Club.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE: The Nominating Committee shall meet annually on or before November 1 to prepare a slate of Officers and Directors for the upcoming year. See By-laws.

PUBLICITY AND MARKETING COMMITTEE: The Publicity and Marketing Committee promotes public awareness and education concerning responsible dog ownership, the Boxer breed, and NJ Boxer Club activities. Its duties include managing the Club's social media, website, and advertising across digital, print, and audio platforms to promote the Boxer breed, responsible dog ownership, and Club events/meetings.

SHOW COMMITTEE: The Show Committee is responsible for managing all aspects of conformation shows, matches, and other trials conducted or sponsored by the Club. Duties include coordinating judge nominations and presenting candidate options for member selection. The Committee's Chair may differ from individual event chairs. The Committee collaborates with the Publicity and Marketing Committee to ensure effective event promotion, and coordinates fundraising activities at shows and events with the Fund-Raising Committee. See Show Chair guidelines for additional details.

NOTE: Committee Chairs are appointed by the President with Board Approval within 30 days after the first general meeting of the year.
